

We Are Proud of Our 2008 ATC Rankings

ÆSIR International Ltd. is extremely proud of its position as one of the top ranked Canadian Autodesk Authorized Training Centers (ATC) in every category. We placed in the Top 5 Canadian ATCs of 40 registered sites* in the following:

#2 in Canada for Facilities and Registrations at 94.9% satisfaction. (The #1 ranked centre was scored at a 95.9% satisfaction rating.)

#3 in Canada for Instructional Quality at 95.9% satisfaction. (The #1 ranked centre was scored at a 97.3% satisfaction rating.)

#4 in Canada for Course Content & Materials at 90.7% satisfaction. (The #1 ranked centre was scored at a 93.7% satisfaction rating.)

#3 in Canada for Overall Performance at 93.7% satisfaction. (The #1 ranked centre was scored at a 94.5% satisfaction rating.)

We are also very proud of our two highly rated trainers. Of 190 registered AAI trainers in Canada, both had Top 10 rankings in 2008.

Heather Sullivan, A.Sc.T., was ranked #1 trainer in Canada by weighted Daily Totals at a perfect score of 100%.

Eric Leitner, C.Tech, OAAAS, was ranked as the #7 trainer in Canada by Weighted Average at a total score of 102.7%. **

Despite our small company size, ÆSIR also did remarkably well in the categories of percent of product trained in Canada in 2008. Our best trained products were:
